- LAKOTA LANGUAGE Utilizing the Lakota Language in instruction for youth

I. RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Assist the Director and educational staff in providing enriching, fun, and safe activities in a variety of indoor and outdoor settings, based on a variety of themes.
- Collaborating with staff to develop culturally appropriate daily games, crafts, and activities that are enhanced with Lakota Language..
- Help to provide a welcoming and safe environment for all campers and staff, regardless of age, ethnicity, gender, and/or physical and mental abilities.
- o Implementing summer camp behavioral policies and emergency procedures.
- Expected to report any major behavioral issues, bullying, or suspected child abuse/neglect to the Director, as soon as possible.
- Assisting fellow camp staff to set up for and clean up after each day, including help with preparing materials and supplies for daily camp activities.
- Assisting with the welcoming and departure of campers each day, in accordance with Mahpíya Lúta School Policies and Procedures.

- Attending all applicable staff training sessions and meetings.
- Input digital curriculum into existing software.
- Other duties, as assigned.

II. POSITION QUALIFICATION AND SKILLS:

- Applicants must be at least 16 years old and have reliable transportation.
- Applicants must be committed to learning and using the Lakhota Language on a daily

basis.

- Prior experience working with children required; at least 1 year preferred.
- Willingness to learn about Native American Culture, Language and Traditions.
- Strong interpersonal skills.
- Ability to collaborate as part of a team.
- Reliable, Responsible, and Flexible.
- Must be willing to submit to a background check, if over the age 18, and take the Youth Safe Environment training.
